You will find a place to graduate

- **Teach-Out Agreement Institutions – Agreements with BSC**
 - Seamless transition and admission process
 - Complete program on schedule
 - Academic program specific, with credits transferred
- **Transfer Agreement Institutions – Agreements with BSC**
 - Ease of admissions process, with specific support for BSC students
 - Suspended deadline
 - Comparable academic programs identified for you
- **Regular Transfer Process to any Institution – No Agreement with BSC**
 - Regular transfer process
 - Work with institution's admissions office to identify academic programs and transferable credits

- May require indication of no active Title IX investigation against you
- Title IX for Athletes typically included
 - Send transfer institution request forms to studev@bsc.edu
 - Through May 30, will respond within one workday
 - Students copied on communication to transfer institutions

Transcripts, prior to May 31
